Biography

Cecile Martin holds a Master in Architecture (MArch). She is a photographer, videographer, performer, stage designer, active in web and public art, and curator of media arts and architecture in Montreal. Over the last ten years, she has participated in exhibitions in France and Canada (Design Exchange, Toronto), responded to many commissioned articles (Centre Pompidou, Paris), taught at the DESS in Event Design at the Université du Québec à Montréal (UQAM), and on many dozens of occasions has given conferences and sat on juries and committees. Her practice has led her to work in Europe, Africa, Oceania, North and South America.

Thus form 2002 till 2008 while she was the general and artistic Director of the organization Champ Libre, Cécile Martin has created sixteen site-specific new media arts events in Montreal and internationally, in public spaces or abandoned heritage buildings. She has then commissioned and supervised collaborative interventions between new media artists and architects. Cécile Martin has been awarded the 2009 Royal Architectural Institute of Canada Foundation Award.

In 2012, among other things, having presented *EXPOSE* at MUTEK during the first Montreal International Biennale of Digital Art (a 10 screens video work, collaboration with sound artist Li Alin of which the 1 screen version was presented during the Festival du Nouveau Cinema in Montreal at PHI Centre), she participated in several residencies including TRYANGLE at the Tanzhaus in Düsseldorf and is creating the stage design for the next show by Berlin choreographer Georg Reischl.
